



As we navigate through this time of COVID-19, we want you to know that Maryville Addiction Treatment Center remains committed to serving those who need us most. Our facilities remain open and continue to accept new patients. This includes our inpatient detox and residential treatment programs in Williamstown and Pemberton as well as our outpatient services in Turnersville, Vineland, and Northfield.

Maryville has made important adjustments to standard operating procedures in accordance with CDC and DOH guidelines. Telehealth services have been added through our outpatient offices as an additional resource.

Maryville has updated its emergency operations protocols to manage COVID-19 risk. We have:

- Increased sanitation protocols for infection control
- Instituted additional screening for COVID-19 symptoms at our inpatient and outpatient facilities in accordance with CDC and DOH guidelines
- Limited visitation to our facilities to that which is essential
- Educated clients and staff on hand and respiratory hygiene, social distancing, and other infection prevention techniques
- Developed protocols for responding to clients presenting with flu-like symptoms in partnership with our local health departments
- Expanded use of our outdoor green spaces for dining and therapeutic activities

The health and safety of our clients and staff are our top priority, and we will adjust our protocols as CDC and DOH guidelines in response to COVID-19 continue to evolve. Thank you for your continued support of Maryville's mission of service to our communities.
